What's next for the students? Our current students are preparing for their year one exams. While they haven't been able to be in school, the government didn't want to hold the students' progress back. The students will take their exams in January to demonstrate what they have learned during this time. If they pass these exams, which we are confident they will be able to, the students will progress to year 2 of Secondary School.

What is next for Reaching Beyond Globally? A new class of P7 students at Deirdre Ann Academy are studying as well. They have already taken their mock exams for Secondary School and have placed second in the district. They studied and prepared for their exams at home until they were able to return to school in October. These students will take their actual exams soon, and then begin the interview process for Secondary School.

Our goal has always been to be able to support any child in financial need to attend Secondary School. We will be continuing our fundraising efforts to secure funds for both groups of students.

What's new with RBG? Unfortunately, Covid-19 hit very close to home, and Vicki Bassing lost her brother Ed, to the virus in March. Ed was an avid reader and book collector and was very invested in education. After speaking with her sister-in-law, Reaching Beyond Globally will be creating a lending library at Deirdre Ann Academy in Ed's honor. We are in the process of putting together a budget for the library and are very excited to be able to continue to spread knowledge and love even from afar.

By matching a student in need with a donor of financial means, Reaching Beyond Globally will enable each child to further their education and give them opportunities to find a career previously thought impossible.
